To Our Parish Community,

On behalf of your Finance Council, we have attached a FY budget report from Jul-Dec 2025. We appreciate your patience with us as we have had a complex financial review that took longer than expected, in part due to a changeover of 3 Bookkeepers.

Happily, we can report that a final reconciliation of our finances is now complete. We owe a great debt of gratitude to Ellen Markham, loaned to us from St. Francis of Assisi, who due to her stellar talent, skill set, and work ethic has provided us with, finally, a confident and true statement of our financial house.

You will see from the financial report provided (ending Dec 2025), the operating costs associated with running our church are quite substantial. In addition, monthly maintenance and utility expenditures are "eye opening", plus salaries, insurance fees, etc., contribute to a very taxing financial burden on our parish.

ACS remains in the hands of the diocesan financial and legal offices, and we have no update but to say the sale has not been completed. We are anxiously waiting to hear from them.

In closing, expect your next quarterly financial statement for Jan-March 2026 within a month, then an end of the FY statement in early July once the end of the year (Jun 30) has been reconciled.
