Mass Etiquette

- Turn off or silence electronics
- Arrive quietly out of respect for those who are praying
- Show reverence by genuflecting to the Tabernacle before entering or leaving the pew
- If you pass before the altar bow reverently
- Participate fully during mass by joining in song and responses
- Refrain from walking up and down aisles during the Consecration and related prayers
- Bow or genuflect before receiving the Eucharist
- When leaving, take any trash (like tissues), or items that you have brought to church
- Leave quietly and do not loiter in the Nave out of respect for those still praying

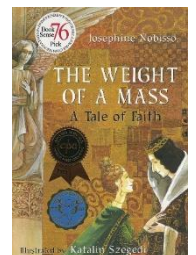

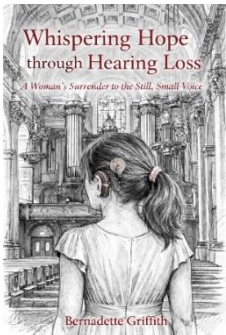
