Last month, during the first week of July, the Rosary makers of St. John asked for help to make 250 rosaries for the beatification of Blessed Bishop Fulton Sheen. The response from our prisoners was more than amazing. We had approximately 12 individuals who volunteered to help. We met for two hours every Monday morning and most took kits home to make more. The most incredible and heartwarming part of this, is that their family members worked with them to put together as many rosaries as possible; Families working together, making rosaries, building memories, with the rosary at the heart of their gathering. Some members of this group are now the Monday morning rosary group who work together and yet separate from the Wednesday evening rosary group. The combined numbers of actual rosary makers cannot be counted, however, we can share with you that not only did we reach our goal of 250 rosaries, but we made 700 rosaries.

We want to thank the parishioners who purchased the beads and supplies and those who paid for the shipping cost to Peoria Illinois. We thank you all for your prayers, excitement and support. There will be an article in the Catholic Virginian in October with all of the news from the beautification ceremony and the work of the rosary makers in our diocese who answered the call.
