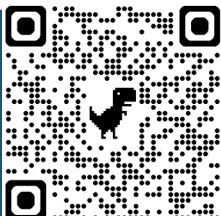
Hello from the Safety Committee!

We are greatly in need of additional volunteers to sing in the choir at all three weekend Masses. We would also like to have a few more instrumentalists to play at Christmas, Easter, and on other major feast days. If you sing regularly during Mass, or if you play a wind, string, or brass instrument, and if you're age 18 or older, I cordially invite you to join our parish music ministry, or to prayerfully consider joining.

Members enjoy friendship with fellow parishioners, improve their musical skills, lead the congregation in worship through sacred music, and experience the joy of using their God-given talents for his honor and glory in the sacred liturgy.

You may object that you're too busy with work and family responsibilities to join the church music ministry. Or maybe you're dealing with some health concerns. Well, many of our current members have work and family responsibilities and health issues too. As a volunteer, you can join and participate on a flexible, personalized schedule. You can practice the music at home at your convenience and sing at the Mass you regularly attend.

Rehearsals are usually held on Monday evenings at 6:30 p.m. and we usually spend 30 to 40 minutes practicing the music for one weekend's Masses. There is also a 20-to-30-minute rehearsal 45 minutes before each Mass. The minimum requirements for choir membership are to sing at one Mass per month and to attend one rehearsal before singing at that Mass.

As baptized Catholics, we're called to use our gifts and talents in service to God and others. If you sing or play an instrument, please join us or prayerfully consider it. Please call or email me or speak with me after Mass if you have any questions or concerns.
